



First phone or visit suggestions **only**:

Start with prayer for the Holy Spirit to speak through you. Call and listen to the tone of voice from the contact. Their tone of voice can tell you whether to keep it short or whether it is good timing and a chance to get to know them a little more.

CONVERSATION

May I speak to (card) Good (morning, afternoon, evening) my name is our organization sponsored a mailing of the booklet "Finding Peace" which was delivered at the end of March and April. I am calling to see if you received the material you requested."

(Yes) If you have any questions feel free to contact PSTC or us at

(No) Describe the booklet "Finding Peace", they may have forgotten, and verify the correct mailing address, and let them know you will contact PSTC to insure material is sent to you.

END of Conversation

The card let's you know what they have requested.

The first contact is usually short unless you sense the Spirit prompting you to go deeper.

I once heard something very important, when making a phone contact, the other person cannot see you but they can still tell by the tone and pitch of your voice whether or not you are smiling. If you were knocking on their door you would approach them with a SMILE.

Remember: Acts 20:35 I have shewed you all things, how that so labouring ye ought to support the weak, and to remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he said, *It is more blessed to give than to receive.*
